



## Sample Bequest Language

**Specific Bequests** allow you to designate a percentage of your estate, a dollar amount, or specified assets as a gift to American Friends of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra (also known as “AFIPO”). After providing for your family and loved ones, a bequest to American Friends of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra ensures that the values you cherish are transmitted to future generations.

### Sample language:

I give, devise and bequeath \_\_\_\_\_ [state a % or \$ amount, or specific property or other asset] to American Friends of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra, located in New York, NY, to be used for its general purposes [or for a particular program or purpose].

**Residual Bequests** allow you to designate the remaining residue of your estate as a gift to American Friends of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra, after the payment of all expenses and specific bequests to other beneficiaries have been made.

### Sample language:

I give, devise and bequeath to American Friends of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra, located in New York, NY, all [or state a percentage] of the rest and residue of my estate to be used for its general purposes [or for a particular program or purpose].

**American Friends of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit**
